**Discussion**: Richard Haether provided an update on upcoming plans for The Carrollwood Cultural Center events. Will include a Summer Music Series. There will be 12 resident events. Todd and Adrienne will have marketing responsibilities using such resources as TBO, Fox Radio, Clear Channel and CBS. Johnny Cash event is generating lots of interest as well. A copy of Press Release will be sent to Board members. Goal is also to increase branding and revenue (by an estimate of 10%).
