4. Executive Director's Report: Paul Berg reported on "Singing in the Rain". Tickets are sold out for this weekend, and just a few are available for the second weekend. Paul said that he is setting up training for the new ticketing system for the staff. The target timeline is Sept. for the new system to be in place. The week of July 22 Paul and Todd will be meeting with this company to put together a

development and grant program. The studio is scheduled to be completely fumigated next week. The county is paying for the tenting and clean up.

- 5. Finance Update: Alan Preston reported that the center is doing well. Overall the center is \$11,000 to the good. Memberships and donations are better than projected. The Finance committee discussed the Strategic Employee planning committee.Bill DeMare said that the committee will start meeting on October 7 at 4:00. Paul will send the job descriptions to the board members.
- 6. Governance Committee: Bill DeMare reminded the board that Nancy Stearns chaired the governance committee, but said that he does not want to chair that committee. He recommended that the committee meet quarterly on pre-set dates. EvelynBless stated that the next meeting is scheduled in October. The board discussed the functioning of the governance committee in relation to the selection of board members. Bill DeMare announced that the Carrollwood Park Conservancy has been talking with Aaron Washington about putting something on as an annual event at the park.
- 7. Unfinished Business: The board was given a copy of the strategic plan and asked to review it. It will be discussed at the next board meeting in August.
- 8. Round Robin: Craig Nowicke is donating a cabinet to the chorus. Alan Preston is going to do a reconciliation of finances. Paul Berg talked about summer camp; there are many returning kids every year. Pre-teens have been a challengethis year. Paul encouraged board members to come by on Friday at 4:00 to see the campers "show and share".
