■ DIRECTOR'S NOTES ■

I am so excited and honored to be directing this production. I started as the Entertainment Director here at the Carrollwood Cultural Center in May and am so excited to be here.

I am an avant-gardist and experimenter at heart and I am very blessed that Paul has accepted my work with open arms. At this performance we are examining two artistic questions at once.

Within the play we are examining the question "What is art?" and I hope you can walk away from the show today asking yourself what it is that defines anything artistic to you. What is ...? Art? Music? Theatre? How far can you personally push those boundaries?

Outside of the play and as a theatre company we are examining the experience of theatre and experimenting with form and space and seeing how far we can artistically push those boundaries, as well.

Personally, what I love about experimentation is the moment something familiar becomes new and the world that opens up to a whole new set of possibilities. Sometimes an experiment works and sometimes is takes a little more refining—the process created within experimentation is always so enlightening and fundamental to what we, as artists, look for to see what happens next.

I hope this play creates the grounds for us to continue to question and explore things in new way every now and then. Listen to a new album, think of how to decorate a space in a new way, and hopefully take at least 5 or 10 minutes occasionally to do something out of your comfort zone.

Yasmina Reza (Playwright) is a French playwright and novelist, based in Paris, whose works have all been multi-award-winning, critical and populare international successes, produced worldwide and translated into 35 languages. She has written seven plays (CONVERSATIONS AFTER A BURIAL, THE PASSAGE OF WIN-TER, "ART," THE UNEXPECTED MAN, LIFE X 3, A SPANISH PLAY, GOD OF CARNAGE, HOW YOU TALK THE GAME) and 6 novels ("Hammerklavier," "Une Desolation (Desolation)," "Adam Haberberg," "Dans la Luge d'Arthur Schopenhaur," "Nulle Part," and "L'Aube, le Soir ou la Nuit (Dawn Dusk of Night)"). Films include: "Le PiqueNique de Lulu Kreutz," directed by Didier Martiny and "Chicas," written and directed by the author.

Christopher Hampton (Translator) Christopher Hampton's plays and musicals have so far garnered four Tony Awards, three Olivier Awards, four Evening Standard Awards, and the New York Drama Critics' Circle Award; prizes for his film and television work include an Oscar, two BAFTAs, a Writers' Guild of America Award, the Prix Italia, a Special Jury Award at the Cannes Film Festival, Hollywood Screenwriter of the Year, and the Collateral Award at the Venice Film Festival for Best Literary Adaptation, Original plays: APPOMAT-TOX, THE TALKING CURE, WHITE CHAMELEON, TALES FROM HOL-LYWOOD, TREATS, SAVAGES, THE PHILANTHROPIST. TOTAL ECLIPSE, and WHEN DID YOU LAST SEE MY MOTHER? Adaptations from novels: YOUTH WITH-OUT GOD (Horváth), EMNBERS (Márai), and LES LIASONS DAN-GEREUSES (Laclos). Musicals: STE-PHEN WARD, DRACULA: THE MU-SICAL, and SUNSET BOULEVARD. Libretti: APPTOMATTOX, THE TRI-AL, and WAITING FOR THE BAR-BARIANS (all for Philip Glass). Translations include plays by Chekhov, Ibsen, Molière, Horváth, Yasmina Reza, and Florian Zeller.
